We wondered why our efforts to fix ourselves and others were not working, no matter how hard we tried. We had come to a crossroad: continue our old ways of coping or look for a new way out of our pain.

**CODA** - A PROGRAM OF RECOVERY FROM CODEPENDENCE, WHERE EACH OF US MAY SHARE OUR EXPERIENCE, STRENGTH, AND HOPE IN OUR EFFORTS TO FIND FREEDOM WHERE THERE HAS BEEN BONDAGE, AND PEACE WHERE THERE HAS BEEN TURMOIL IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH OTHERS AND OURSELVES.

#### WHAT IS A MEETING?

A CoDA meeting is comprised of a group of people who come together around their shared desire for healthy and loving relationships. The group uses the Twelve Steps and **Twelve Traditions of Co-Dependents Anonymous** as the basis for working toward recovery. It is a place to find sponsorship and fellowshin as well as the sharing of experience, strength, and hope, A strong sense of acceptance and community makes a meeting attractive to both the newcomer and old-timer.


